WHAT THE BOOK ARGUES

Most parish renewal efforts fail because they come from the top down. A parish tries something that worked somewhere else, but their church is different, so it flounders. Renewal happens from the ground up with the buy-in of the average parishioner.

Save Your Parish activates those parishioners. The book is centered around the four floors, the four jobs every parish is tasked with: help people meet each other, help people meet Jesus, help people learn the faith, help people share the faith (*Christifideles Laici* 11).

The book is written for laypeople who have no staff, no budget, and no authority, **but** the change happens faster with buy-in from the parish staff – and more importantly, the priests. The good thing is nothing in it requires you to fund a new initiative or add to your calendar. Clergy and staff can absolutely use it, but it doesn't wait on them to begin.

Save Your Parish's approach is grounded in the principles of Paul VI and John Paul II on evangelization, and focused on traditional Catholic approaches to evangelization rather than repackaging more popular megachurch methods.
